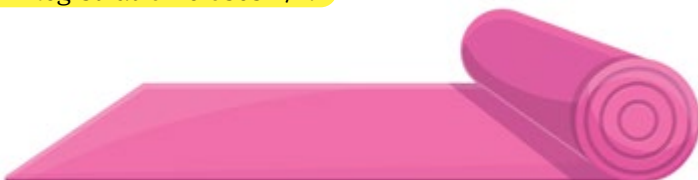

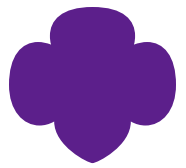

GIRL SCOUT TREE PROMISE gs

The Girl Scout Tree Promise (GSTP) provides girls with an opportunity to act as environmental stewards and work to slow climate change on a national level. It invites everyone to help plant 5 million trees in 5 years while protecting and honoring many more. 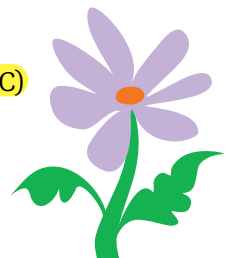

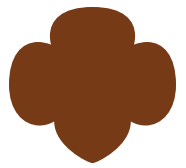

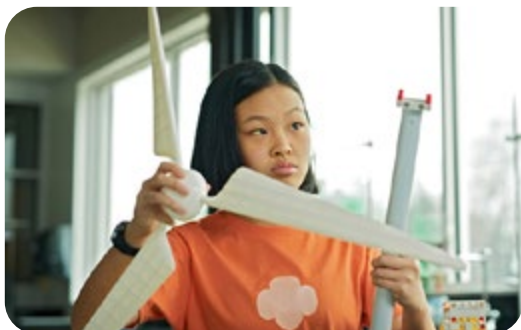
